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It took off in the .com boom, when listings were first able to be posted online, which helped bring options to buyers.

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
It is one of the only sectors that completely overlapped in all vertical markets of real estate. PropTech has been revered for helping create a more collaborative economy and simplify real estate processes.

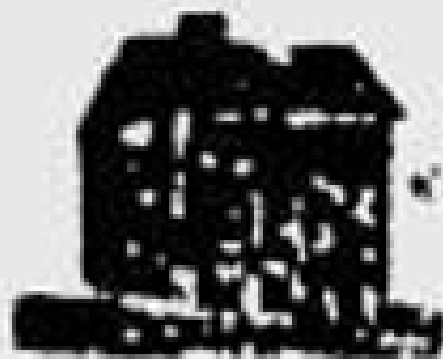
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GRAND RAPIDS, MICHIGAN.—Several well improved farms for **sale** near the village of Grand Rapids on Grand River.
